The goal of this program is to form community through working the land. The focus is on two groups, the youth and the elders of our town. The purpose of this project is to bring the youth and the elderly together to work the land with a common goal; to plant nurture and harvest crops.

This project will enhance the opportunities for multi-generational families to learn and work together.

The program includes education seminars, practical workshops and field trips learning about:

- Land Conservation through Sustainable Farming
- Permaculture; planting a sustainable and edible landscape
- Traditional Native American farming practices

The harvest will be shared with those in the elder community who may not have access to, or be able to afford, fresh local produce. That which is not distributed will be sold to market, farmers market, food cooperatives and restaurants, to help support and augment the project, with the goal of becoming self sustaining.

All involved will learn skills that are both useful and practical while experiencing the excitement of growing beautiful and useful plants, in community for community. Individuals have the opportunity to provide for themselves and others by assisting in food production.
